

### **Focus on Foundations Courses**

Focus on Foundations classes teach key standards needed to build a strong foundation that leads to long-term academic success. This foundation-focus means students spend time mastering the most vital skills in each subject, ensuring they can catch-up more quickly and understand what's being taught in their regular classes. For students who are already at grade-level, students can quickly advance well beyond their grade level.

## Math

#### **Focus on Foundations:**

Math covers both math concepts and math applications. In conceptual portions, students master the overarching number sense upon which all math is built. In application portions, students learn critical thinking and problem solving as they apply key concepts to mathematical applications and word problems.

## Reading

#### **Focus on Foundations:**

Reading hones student's comprehension skills and supports improved reading fluency. Beginning with targeted lessons on specific comprehension skills, the skills are further honed using short fiction. The alternating classes are spent reading real books together aloud, allowing students to apply their comprehension skills to literature in real time.

## Writing

#### Focus on Foundations:

Writing covers both grammar and composition skills. The grammatical portions focus on learning the logic and structure of the English language. The composition portions teach students to apply their grammatical knowledge to express their own ideas and thoughts with clarity and style.

## **Summer Private Tutoring**

We offer Private Tutoring for students of all ages in all subjects. Private tutoring during the summer is a great chance to get targeted, individual support to catch up or get ahead!

Students in private tutoring can enroll for specific Subject Tutoring or for 1:1 support to help students stay on track during summer school courses.

(For students enrolled in summer credit recovery courses, it is recommended to enroll for 2 or more hours a week to ensure the best results).

## **Luck of Legends: Creative Writing**

This unique approach to creative writing combines the fun of tabletop games with collaborative storytelling, all while practicing five Common Core Standards and developing real-life skills like cooperation, active listening, and clear communication.

Together, students build a world in which anything they write becomes a part of the adventure they get to explore. Similar to popular tabletop role-playing games like Dungeons & Dragons, students will tell stories of adventure and overcoming challenges, but with an emphasis on creative problem solving rather than combat.

The stories will be assembled into a portfolio for parents to read through, as well as academic feedback on the five Common Core standards that detail your student's areas of growth and opportunities for further development.

## **Socratic Honors Academy**

This course equips students to be lifelong learners and scholars, by integrating English, History and the other Humanities. Students journey thematically through enjoyable literature, write analytical papers, research historical context and learn to present their ideas and argue thoughtfully through dialectic-style discussion groups. As part of the class, students will go on excursions all around LA exploring art museums, watching Shakespeare in the Park, and much more!

Students focus on 3-4 key texts written by great authors of Western and World literary traditions. Each 2-week camp includes designated time for reading as well as a 2-hr Socratic Discussion daily. All of our Socratic courses focus on writing as a key element of academic success. Students must be able to express their ideas in eloquently written essays with clear argumentation and purpose. All students are required to complete multiple short writing assignments and a capstone paper or presentation.

Students are provided 2-hr writing workshops on T/Th to support their writing development.

#### Middle School

Socratic Honors Academy for middle school students centers on specific literary analysis frameworks needed for English classes: The Hero's Journey, Character Archetypes, or Symbolism. There is a focus on developing argumentation through short answer essays and a capstone presentation which demonstrates the use and understanding of the analytical framework taught in class.

## **High School**

Socratic Honors Academy for high school is more about student-directed genre studies, chosen by the Socratic Honors Club during their Spring semester. There is a focus on honing and polishing argumentation, as students will spend their two weeks writing a college-level capstone paper that either provides an analysis of a work in their chosen genre or a narrative showcasing the genre elements in their own creative work.

## Get Ready: STEM - Math & Science

Through our Get Ready classes, students prepare for challenging math and science courses by learning the foundations they need to succeed during the school year. Students starting Honors or AP courses are especially encouraged to enroll, as these classes assume a strong understanding of foundational material that most students have not been actively taught.

Get Ready courses are taught as 2-week intensives, and will focus on ensuring students have the pre-requisite knowledge required for the course along with pre-teaching key concepts they will encounter in the Fall.

At the end of each class, students will have learned core material while creating a reference guide of key terms and equations and multiple study aids for use throughout the year.

### Get Ready: Chemistry, Biology, Physics

Science classes (especially Honors & AP) expect students to walk through the door with a working knowledge of the subject, even though most students haven't touched the material since middle school, if they've learned it at all.

Get Ready for Science teaches your student the foundations of Chemistry, Biology or Physics they need to understand what's happening in class, as well as key content from the year to ensure they're already familiar with core material so it's easier when they reach it in school.

### Get Ready: Math A, B, C

A strong foundation in algebraic operations, functions, and geometry are key to student success in math and that is exactly what we build in our Get Ready for Math classes (formerly called Foundations of Algebra & Geometry).

In Get Ready for Math, students will cover prerequisite knowledge they must have mastered before starting their school-year math classes, along with covering major topics from their Fall semesters to give them a head start on mastering math!

## **College Counseling**

College represents one of the first major milestones on the path to adulthood, with the process of applying and getting accepted to a school of choice acting as the first true test of a student's ability to make choices like an adult.

What students need in this season is not just support, but also room to practice independent decision-making and experience the weight of increased responsibility before it's time to step out fully on their own.

The College Counseling program provides that balance between supporting a student's independence and providing transitional guidance.

Working directly with Karyn Keene, students receive strategic advising, guidance on how to manage the application process and support on how to craft an application essay.

College Counseling is available to students as early as 9th grade.
